- 2. Activating Relevant University Committees for effective service delivery and prompt response to infractions and or breaches of the extant Regulations
- 3. Strict monitoring and enforcement of discipline
- 4. Re-introduction of the Committee on Reward for Excellence
- 5. Prompt processing of Certificates
- 6. On-going digitalization of students' records with a view to fast-tracking the processing of transcripts and elimination of all corrupt practices associated with the process.
- 7. Reactivation of inaugural lectures
- 8. Plugging of loopholes for financial leakages
- 9. Ongoing efforts aimed at proving utilities on Campus
- 10. Promotion of fundamental principle of 'Management by Inclusive Participation'
- 11. Activation of good working relations among the Unions and between the University Management and the Unions
- 12. Imbuing professionalism, passion, ownership and competitive mind-set among the leaderships at the various levels of the University Administration among other critical breakthroughs
- 13. On going conduct of Staff Verification Exercise
- 14. Initiating robust Public-Private Partnerships to boost the financial base
- 15. Planting of oil palm seedlings
- 16. Setting up high-powered Committee of Town and Gown for Centre of Engineering and related Departments/Units
- 17. On-going construction of ESUT Pavilion
- 18. Staff-Students welfare projects among several programmes

None the less, the above modest achievements are made possible by the support of His Excellency, The Executive Governor of Enugu State, Dr Lawrence Ifeanyi Ugwuanyi, CON.
